

### THE NAMES OF THE SAVIOUR

God named the Saviour Jesus Christ "Immanuel", which means "God with us". In biblical culture, a person's name specifies the person's identify, status or office. Jesus Christ is the God who dwells with His people.

Is having God dwelling with us at all times a desirable thing? That depends on what He is like. If He is one who penalises us punitively every time we violate His rules, and always robs us of freedom, then frankly, it would be miserable. Through the prophet Isaiah, God also told us that this Saviour is to be named:

"Wonderful Counsellor" – one who journeys with us through the thick and thin of life, is empathetic and guides us in decisions with godly wisdom,

"Almighty God" – one who is in control of all things and whose power transcends all circumstances, even physical laws that He Himself established,

"Everlasting Father" – a loving and merciful heavenly father who never leaves us or forsakes us, and

"Prince of peace" – one whose mission is to rebuild and sustain our intimate relationship with God, a mission that He accomplished by sacrificing Himself on the cross.

Such a God being with us is a blessing far beyond the rich blessing of having a loving earthly family and a faithful friend. Even since His creation of the world, God's heart is to enjoy a loving intimate personal relationship with each one of us whom He has created. It was for this purpose that He sent the Saviour Jesus Christ at the first Christmas in the form of a human, so that He could represent humankind to pay the debt of sin, in order that those who believe in Him will be adopted back into God's family again to be His children.

The Apostle John said when Jesus came, the world rejected Him, "Yet to all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name (meaning those who accept Him for who He is as His names indicate), He gave the right to become children of God" John's Gospel 1:11-12. Would you open your heart this Christmas to receive Him as your Saviour and Lord, so that you will truly be able to celebrate "Immanuel - God with us"?
